Proposed Course Sequence
For Transfer Students From
Sault College's Practical Nursing Program

The proposed completion timetable for these transferring students is based on the following assumptions:

1) These classes have transferred in:

- ENGL110 First Year Composition I
- HLTH209 Pharmacology
- HLTH232 Pathophysiology
- NURS211 Introduction to Professional Nursing
- NURS212 Health Appraisal
- NURS213 Nursing Fundamentals
- NURS327 Adult Nursing
- PSYC101 Introduction to Psychology
- SOCY101 Introduction to Sociology

Note: Transfer credit for the NURS courses will **not** be awarded until the student successfully completes NURS?: Nursing Transition – Concepts course and the Ontario Practical Nurse Registration Examination.

2) Based on particular courses in their program, the following courses have been waived:

- BIOL121 Human Anatomy & Physiology I
- BIOL122 Human Anatomy & Physiology II
- PSYC155 Lifespan Development

3) These students have completed enough credits at Sault College to bring the total credits to at least the 127 required for graduation.

4) These students must have successfully completed the Ontario Practical Nurse Registration examination.

5) The course schedules for Fall 2006 and Spring 2007 were used to determine the following proposed course sequence. Therefore, the timetable is subject to change.

- This course sequence assumes the students successfully complete MATH086, the pre-requisite for MATH102, which is scheduled in the first fall semester.
- # means the course is offered every semester and not a pre-requisite, so can be moved around.
