Sault College continues to participate in the education of Native students in various programs across the College. Our Native student population continues to grow each year. This is in part, because the College recognizes and attempts to meet Native students' needs in a variety of ways.

The Native Student Centre - Enji Maawnjiding provides a "home base" for Native students from all programs.

The Director of Native Education & Training, Assistant to the Director, Native Student Counsellor, Native Student Services Officer, Faculty and Support Staff have offices close to the Native Student Centre. All staff takes an active interest in student success and are readily available when students need them.

Native Student Council (NSC)

The Council has the following three objectives:

1. To unite Sault College students, especially those of Native descent, through social, cultural and sports events;
2. To provide a linkage for College students with the larger Native and non-Native community;
3. To assist students in furthering their education.
