Proposed Course Sequence
For Transfer Students From
Sault College PTA/OTA Program

The following courses are proposed for those transferring based on the following assumptions:

- 1) These credits have transferred in:
 - ENGL110-3 First Year Composition I
 - EXER140-3 Health and Fitness
 - EXER141-3 Introduction to Movement
 - EXER275-2 Nutrition for Sport
 - BIOL121-4 Anatomy and Physiology I
 - BIOL122-4 Anatomy and Physiology II
 - PSYC101-3 Introduction to Psychology
 - PSYC 155-3 Life Span Development (designated as a Cognate Elective)
 - HLTH232-3 Pathophysiology
 - 5 additional Cognate electives
 - 3 Departmental electives
 - 3 HMSV electives
 - 7 General electives
- 2) The student has completed enough credits at Sault College which, combined with those of the LSSU courses to be taken, will bring the total credits to more than the 125 required for graduation.
- 3) EXER340: Therapeutic Modalities in Athletic Training is one of the Departmental electives in this LSSU degree. Work is being done to determine the viability of making this a transferred course, but at this point, the student will have to take EXER340 at LSSU to earn credit for it.
- 4) Course schedules from Fall 2006 and Spring 2007 were used to determine the following proposed course sequence. Therefore, the timetable is subject to change.

Note: It is essential that the transferring OTA/PTA student complete MATH102 or its equivalent before Semester 1 at LSSU. There are a number of ways the student might do this:

- complete the equivalent course at Sault College during the two years there
- take the COMPASS Math Assessment test as soon as dual enrolled and then, *if necessary*, either take the specific classes at LSSU in the evening or begin the PLATO series of MATH081-086 and MATH102
- take the needed MATH course(s) in the Summer term just before the first fall
