** When the LASA or PFP grads enrol in the third year, there are spaces in their timetables because of courses already taken. If they could fill these with an equivalent course or courses (e.g. Speech, Abnormal Psychology, Math, Physics) they will need after they transfer, it would lessen the time required to complete the degree.
